
Step 1 Attach wheel 9 on the base plate (A), and tighten with bolt 2




Step 2 Attach post (C) on the assembled base plate (A) in step 1, and tighten them




 $Step \ 3 \ \ Install \ plate(B) \ on \ the \ post, \ and \ use \ bolt \ 1 \ to \ tighten$




 $Step \ 4 \quad \text{Install wall mount(E) on the post, and use bolt } \ 3 \ \ to \ tighten$



 $Step\ 5\ \text{Attach the bracket (D) on the back of the IFP, use suitable bolt to tighten them}$



Step 6 Hold the IFP with assembled bracket on the wall plate, and tighten the safety bolts




